

CANADA EQUIPMENT WARRANTY

K - 0 - % 0 N % & K (hereinafter "Seller") warrants to the original purchaser for use (hereinafter "Buyer") that Equipment manufactured by or for the Seller shall be free from defects in material and % workmanship and shall conform to its published specifications. With respect to all non-Seller Equipment, Seller % gives no warranty, and only the warranty, if any, given by the manufacturer shall apply. Rechargeable batteries% are excluded from this warranty and are warranted under a separate Rechargeable Battery Warranty (ECR-7081).

K Seller's obligations set forth in Paragraph C below shall apply only to failures to meet the above warranties% occurring within the following periods of time from date of sale to the Buyer and are conditioned on Buyer's % giving written notice to Seller within thirty (30) days of such occurrence:

; Kfor fuses and non-rechargeable batteries, operable on arrival only

< Kfor service parts, ninety (90) days

= Kfor mobile and portable radios ("Subscriber Units"), twenty-four (24) months

> Kfor Unity® model Subscriber Units, thirty-six (36) months

? Kfor radio accessories, one (1) year

@ Kfor all other equipment of Seller's manufacture, one (1) year

K During the Warranty Period, if Hardware fails to meet the foregoing warranties, Seller shall, at its option,% correct the failure by: (1) repairing defective or damaged parts or Hardware, or (2) making available any%necessary repaired or replacement parts, or (3) by providing new or refurbished parts or new or refurbished % equipment. Seller will be responsible for shipping charges incurred in returning repaired parts, replacement %parts, or
